

VWL BOARD OF DIRECTORS POLICY #2014-1  
Unanimously Approved on July 22, 2014  
Subject: Pool Rules

Amended Rules

1. The swimming pool and spa are for the use of residents and their guests only.
2. Pool users swim at their own risk. There is no lifeguard.
3. All minors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult homeowner (HO) or renter. If the HO or renter is not present, they must designate an accountable adult.
4. All users will shower before entering the pool. Lotions, oils, and grease can harm the filter system.
5. The hot tub is for adult use only. Hot tubs can be dangerous for children.
6. Hot tub users must turn off the hot tub switch after each use.
7. Homeowners should inform guests of the rules, ask violators of the rules to comply with the rules, and report violations to any member of the Board.
8. Violations of the following rules by homeowners, renters, or guests will result in the following sanctions against the homeowner: assessment of a fine of \$25 for the first violation, the assessment of a fine of \$100 for the second violation, and the loss of pool privileges for a time to be determined by the Board for subsequent violations:
  - a. For safety and health reasons, diving, running, and pets are not allowed in the pool area.
  - b. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area.
  - c. Glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.
  - d. Plastic pants are required on children who are not potty trained.
  - e. A maximum of four guests (not including overnight house guests) for each HO or renter is permitted.
  - f. Entry into the pool area outside of the hours of operation (8:00 AM to 9:00 PM) is not permitted.
